She is currently working for the Institute of Economics and Peace, a non-profit think tank dedicated to shifting the world's focus to peace as a positive, achievable, and tangible measure of human well-being and progress. Each year, the Institute releases the Global Peace Index, which measures the peacefulness of 162 nations and calculates the global cost of violence. In November, the Institute released the first-ever Mexico Peace Index, a holistic analysis of peace across the states of Mexico.
