He has been an academic and professor of the American University of Acapulco, Anahuac del Sur, Iberoamericana, ITAM, Escuela Libre de Derecho and for the Institute of Legal Research of the UNAM. He has also participated as a representative and speaker at public and private institutions for Mexico in international forums and has published several publications.
