Dr Mark Orkin is a Visiting Professor in the School of Government at University of Witwatersrand, Johannesburg (Wits), and an Associate Fellow of the Department of Social Policy and Intervention at Oxford. Previously he was Director-General of the civil service college PALAMA, CEO of the Human Sciences Research Council, Head of Statistics South Africa, Professor of Research Methodology in the Wits Management Faculty, and founder-director of an anti-apartheid social research NGO, CASE. His consultancies include advice on the survey analysis of the impacts of familial HIV/AIDS among South African youth to an Oxford University research team; and on governance statistics to the UNDP and to the programme on Strategic Harmonization of Statistics for Africa (SHaSA). He has written or co-authored sixty journal articles and chapters, and a book. His degrees are from Wits, Oxford and Sussex.
