Professor of Criminology at the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore in Milan since 2003 (before at University of Trento and Rome La Sapienza). He is also as Director of Transcrime, the Joint Research Centre on Transnational Crime (www.transcrime.it). He is also coordinator of the International PhD Programme in Criminology of the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore in cooperation with other Italian and foreign universities. He was also nominated President of the European Society of Criminology for the years 2003–04. He has been consultant to the United Nations, Council of Europe (where he was appointed one of the seven members of the Scientific and Criminological Council in 1996), the European Union and various national governments.

From 1990 to 1994, he was visiting fellow and project director at the National Institute of Justice, Research Centre of the US Department of Justice, Washington DC, where he was manager of two projects on organised crime and international money laundering.

Member of the EU Commission experts group on policy needs for data on crime and criminal justice he is today Chair of the Global Agenda Council on Organized Crime of the World Economic Forum for the term 2011-2012.
