



## **Eduardo Sojo Garza Aldape**

Has combined his professional life in two main areas: public service and the academia.

He was Chief of Staff of President Vicente Fox, Economic Advisor to Felipe Calderón Hinojosa during his presidential campaign, and member of their transition teams.

At the Public Service level, Dr. Sojo served as Chief of the Presidential Office for Public Policy and Coordinator of the Economic Cabinet, 2000-2006, and as Secretary of Economy, 2006-2008.

In the academic field, he was a full-time lecturer and researcher at the Instituto Tecnológico y de Estudios Superiores de Monterrey and research analyst of the Link Project at the University of Pennsylvania, with joint publications with the Nobel Prize in Economics, Lawrence Klein, on the combination of econometric and time-series models.

Among his recent publications highlights the books: "From alternation to development" and "Public Policies in Democracy."

He is currently the President of the Board of Governors of the National Institute of Statistics and Geography of Mexico.

He was born in Leon, Guanajuato, on January 9, 1956.
