

## **National Technical Meeting on the Measurement of Illicit Financial Flows (IFFs)**

The international commitment to countering IFFs is reflected in indicator 16.4.1 of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDA), which measures the total value of inbound and outbound illicit financial flows. This indicator was defined to significantly reduce illicit financial and arms flows, strengthen the recovery of stolen assets and combat all forms of organized crime by 2030.

As the custodian agency of this indicator, the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), through the Center of Excellence (CoE) for Statistical Information on Government, Public Security, Victimization, is developing a pilot measurement of FFI related to criminal activities to test a methodological framework in four selected countries - Colombia, Ecuador, Mexico and Peru - during the period 2019-2020.

Representatives from the relevant national institutions of Mexico, from the UNODC CoE in Mexico will meet with the following objective:

- Present IFFs preliminary estimates related to illicit drug and smuggling migrants in Mexico as part of this pilot measurement.
