Note: This questionnaire uses the categories of the International Classification of Crime for Statistical Purposes (ICCS) describing criminal behaviour instead of using criminal offences. The ICCS is a methodological tool for the statistical classification of crimes, promoted by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime and approved by the United Nations Statistical Commission and the United Nations Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice in 2015.

The LACSI questionnaire has been discussed in seven meetings and one specialized technical meeting on cybercrime of the Working Group on Victimization Surveys for Latin America and the Caribbean. These meetings were promoted by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) through its UNODC-INEGI Centre of Excellence in Statistical Information on Government, Crime, Victimization and Justice and the support of the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), the Organization of American States (OAS) and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP). The questionnaire has been drafted and edited by UNODC and Centre of Excellence staff and discussed with 13 countries in the Latin American and Caribbean region.
